Noislet at & before the Sealing & Delivery hereof the receipt whereof the s^d James
Brooks & Martha his wife doth hereby acknowledge & thereof doth acquit the
said Cordall Noislet his heirs Executors & Administrators. All which granted
Bargained Sold alien'd enfeoff'd Confirmed & made Over & by these presents
doth grant Bargain sell alien & enfeoff and confirm & make over unto the
s^d Cordall Noislet his heirs and assigns forever the following Tract parcel
or Dividend of Land containing Two hundred Acres lying & being in the
County afores^d on the North side of Meherrin River & bounded as follows
Granted to James Brooks bearing date the 20 day of January 1766 To
