 & sell unto the s^r Robert Barham and to his heirs & assigns, All that plantation tract or
 parcel of Land whereon the s^r Robert Barham now lives situate lying & being in
 the Parish of St Luke in county afores^d Containing two hundred & fifty acres be the same
 more or less, and bounded according to the phoning ancient and reputed bounds then of the same
 more being granted by Patent to the s^r Charles Barham duly recorded in the Secretary
 Office of this Colony together with these following negro slaves to wit Dick Peter Sam
 & Dinah together with the future increase of the s^r Dinah To have and to hold
 the s^r Plantation tract or parcel of Land & premises with the appurtenances
 together with the negro slaves Dick Peter Sam & Dinah & the increase of the said
 Dinah unto the s^r Robert Barham and to his heirs & assigns To the only proper
 use & behoof of the s^r Robert Barham his heirs and assigns forever and it is hereby
 Covenanted granted & agreed by & Between the Parties to these presents that he
 Charles Barham notwithstanding this Indenture or any thing therein contained shall
 have hold use Occupy possess & enjoy the hereby granted premises Lands
 and Slaves for and during the term of his natural life and no longer & that from
 immediately after the death of him the s^r Charles Barham it shall be Lawfull to
 and for the s^r Robt Barham his heirs or assigns to enter into & take possession the herein before
 Mentioned Lands & Slaves & their increase & them & every part parcel of them peaceably
 & Quietly to have hold possess and enjoy without the lett suit Trouble or disturbance
 of him the s^r Charles Barham his heirs or assigns or of any Person claiming by from
 or under him or them according to the true intent & meaning of these presents In
 Witness whereof The parties to these presents have hereunto interchangeably set their
 hands & seals the day & year first above written
