Know all Men by these Presents that I Thomas Wainright in the County of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Pounds Current money of Virginia to me in hand paid by Alldredge Jones of the County of Southampton whereof I do acknowledge the receipt & myself therewith fully satisfied have Bargained sold set over and delivered & by these presents in plain & open Market according to due form of Law do bargain seal & delivered unto the said Alldredge Jones sixteen Hoggs one bed & furniture one Gun four Poster Plates One Basin, one dish Three hundred pounds of Iron Three Chain two pots One Tray one Pan one Chest one Iron Shovel To have & to hold the said bargained premises unto the s^d Alldredge Jones his Ex^{rs} adm^r or assigns to the only Proper use and behoof of the s^d Alldredge Jones his Ex^{rs} adm^r or assigns and assigns forever and the s^d Tho^s Wainright for myself my Ex^{rs} adm^r or assigns I Bargained premises unto the s^d Alldredge Jones his Ex^{rs} adm^r or assigns against all and all Manner of Persons shall and will warrant & defend by these presents Provided Nevertheless that if I the s^d Tho^s Wainright my Ex^{rs} adm^r or assigns or any of us do or shall well and Truly pay or cause to be paid unto the s^d Alldredge Jones his Ex^{rs} adm^r or assigns the sum of Ten Pounds on or before the 10 day of March next which shall be in the year of our Lord 1774 for the redemption of the s^d bargained premises then this present writing or bill of Sale to be Void or Else to Remain in full force Power & Virtue In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the 15 day of January in the 11 year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third King of Great Britain & in the year of our Lord God 1774
