 absolutely give and grant to the sd. Thos. Suter to him & his heirs forever One
 Negro Girl called Lucy & her increase Likewise I give to my well
 beloved Son Henry Suter one Neg. fellow called Coff to him & his heirs
 forever Likewise I give to my beloved daughter Ann Suter One Neg. woman
 Jane and One Boy named York & their increase to her & his heirs forever Likewise
 I give to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Suter one Neg. woman named Bess &
 my Boy named Jacob & their increase to her & his heirs forever Likewise
 I give to my well beloved Daughter Martha Suter one Neg. man Harry & One
 Neg. woman Jenny & One Boy Ellick & their increase to her & his heirs forever
 To have and to hold all the aforesd. Negroes or their proper right forever
 Absolutely without any manner of condition as the sd. John Suter have
 Absolutely & of my own accord & put in further Testimony In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 11 day of July in the year of our
 Lord God 1774 John Suter (Seal)
