This Indenture made the 8 day of Sep^r in the fourteenth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. in the year of our Lord God 1774 Between John Reese & Mary his wife of St Lukes Parish in the County of Southampton of the one part & Edward Reese of the parish & County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d John Reese for & in consideration of the sum of Seventy Pounds Current money of Virginia to the s^d John Reese in hand paid by the s^d Edward Reese the receipt whereof the s^d John Reese doth hereby acknowledge he the s^d John Reese hath & doth grant bargain & sell assign & confirm unto the s^d Edward Reese his heirs & assigns forever all that certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying & being in the Parish & County aforesaid & on the Northside of three Creeks containing by Estimation one hundred & five acres or there more or less & bounded as followeth, to wit, Beginning at a Black Jack a corner tree Between John Johnson Benjamin Lewis & the aforesaid John Reese thence along the Line Between Benjamin Lewis & John Reese to a Elm near the North Run of the Three Creeks a corner tree Between Beny Lewis Edward Reese & the s^d John Reese thence along the s^d Edward Reese's Line to his corner white Oak thence along the s^d Reese's line to another white oak thence along the s^d Reese's Line to his corner Red Oak in the aforesaid Beny Lewis's Line thence along the s^d Reese's Line to the black Jack began at. and all houses Buildings orchards Lands & advantages whatsoever to the s^d Tract or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining & also all the Estate right Title Int^r property Claim &
