To all People to whom these presents shall come I Ann Kennel do send Greeting. Knowye that I the said Ann Kennel of the Parish St. Luke and county of Southampton for in consideration of the Love good will & natural affection which I have & do bear towards my two sons Jacob Kennel & Shadrach Kennel of the county & Parish aforesaid have Given & Granted & by these presents do freely give & Grant unto my two sons three Negroes to wit Tistet Jern & Sarah to be equally divided between them and their heirs To have & to hold all the said slaves & their increase to them the said Jacob Kennel and Shadrach Kennel and their heirs from henceforth as their proper and absolute slaves without any manner of further consideration. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11 day of August 1774

Know all Men by these presents that I Brittain Pope of Southampton county and colony of Virginia for in consideration of the sum of fifty five pounds current money of the Colony aforesaid to me in hand paid by Edmund Day Innholder of the county and Colony of Apos^{ts} whereunto I confess myself to be fully satisfied content and paid have Bargained and sold and by these presents do fully, clearly and absolutely bargain and sell unto Edmund Day in plain and open Market according to Law being now in my possession one negro man named Jim or Jimboy Valued at about sixty pounds currency One Neg. Lad named Mingo Valued at about twenty pounds likewise Together with all right Title & property that may Descend to me by right of Marriage to or by my Mother's thirds or part of Dower on the day of her death To have and to hold the said mentioned neg. & right of Marriage to the said Edmund Day his Ex^{ors} Adm^{rs} and assigns as his & theirs our proper goods & Chattels to him and their own proper use & behoof forever & of this Brittain Pope for me my heirs Ex^{ors} Adm^{rs} and every of us the said bargain and Neg. & right of Marriage unto the said Edm. Day his heirs Ex^{ors} Adm^{rs} against all People shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this Twenty fifth day of August 1774
