and Colony aforesaid: whereunto I do hereby certify myself to be fully satisfied content
and paid, have bargained, and sold by these presents do fully
clearly & absolutely bargain and sell unto Edmund Day in plain &
open Market according to Law (being now in my possession) One Negro Wench
named Jall To have and to hold the said mentioned Negro Wench to the said
Day his heirs & assigns & their own proper goods & chattles to his &
their own proper use & behoof for ever and I the said Brittain Pope
for me my heirs & assigns and every of us the said bargained neg. Wench unto
the said Edmund Day his heirs & assigns a quit & against all People shall
and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed my seal this seventh day of
May in the year of our Lord God 1774

Brittain Pope and ordered to be recorded.

Hines & Ann his wife of Southhampton County & Parish of Mottoway of the one
part & Richard Parker of the County of Sussex of the other, said Witneppeth
that the said John Hines & his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
Sixty Pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid the receipt
whereof they do hereby acknowledge, they the said John Hines & Ann his wife
have given granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed by these presents
do give grant bargain sell & confirm unto the said Richard Parker & to his heirs forever
One certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in the County of
Southhampton aforesaid, containing by Estimation One hundred acres
be the same more or less & is bounded as follow to wit Beginning at
a black Oak by the main road then running along a line of marked trees
to a Black Oak in Richard Parkers line then along Parkers line to the
Pines & Oak'd, a corner of William Simmons Land then along Simmons
line to the road aforesaid then along the road to the Beginning And
also all Trees woods underwoods profits commodities & advantages whatsoever
to the said piece or parcel of Land hereby bargained, sold or intended to be
bargained & sold belonging or in anywise appertaining & also the reversion
& reversion Remainder & Remainders unto Issues & Profits thereof Premises
& of every part thereof & all the Estate right title claim & Demand whatsoever
of them the said John Hines & Ann his wife of the said piece or parcel
