This Indenture made this 29 day of January in the year of our Lord Christ 1776 Between, Tho^r Turner & Ann his wife of the parish of Northway & County of Southampton of the one part & Thomas Willmson of the same parish & County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Tho^r Turner & Ann his wife for in consideration of the sum of Fifty seven pounds Eleven Shillings current money of Silver to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Willmson at or before the executing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Tho^r Turner & Ann his wife do hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said Th^r Willmson his heirs and assigns by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed, and doth by these presents grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto the said Th^r Willmson & his heirs & assigns one certain, Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation, one hundred acres or thereabouts more or less lying & being in the parish & County aforesaid bounded as followeth Viz. beginning at a small branch that runs into the Duke's Branch & so along the said Branch to the head thence along a line of marked trees to a small Gurn standing in the line branch & so up the line branch to the head thence along a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree, thence along a line of marked trees to the deep branch & so down the said branch to the first station being the plantation whereon the said Thomas Turner now lives & all houses outhouses buildings edifices yards gardens Orchards woods Trees ways waters watercourses profits & commonalties Mercurials & appurtenances to the said Tract, or parcel of Land belonging or in any way appertaining & the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rents & profits thereof & of every part or parcel thereof & all deeds evidences & writings touching or in any way concerning
