of our sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain
France & Ireland King Defender of the faith, &c. in the year of our Lord
Christ 1774 Between Groves Sharp of the parish of S. Luke & County of
Southampton, of the one part & David Hines of the Parish & County of said
Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d. Groves Sharp for & in consideration
of the sum of Sixty pounds current money of King^m to him in hand paid
at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the hereof he does
hereby acknowledge himself to be here with fully satisfied
contented & paid have granted bargained & aliened enfeofed, released
and confirmed & by presents do grant bargain & sell alien Enfeof release
& confirm to the s^d. David Hines his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel
of land lying & being in the Parish & County afores^d & contains 150 acres
& is bounded as followeth Beginning at a pin in Westbrookes line
thence along the s^d. Westbrookes line to a pin in Puspilla Persons line
thence by Persons line to a white oak in the s^d. Chappels line thence to
a white oak in John Fosters line thence along Fosters line to a
Gum in Dunns Branch thence to a Gum in Westbrookes line
and along Westbrookes line to the Beginning. It being the land
the said Sharp purchased of Moses Westbrooke & also the reversion &
reversions remainder & remainders rents Issues & services thereof
together with all the Estate right title Interest property claim and
Demand whatsoever of him the s^d. Groves Sharp of in & to the said
one hundred & fifty acres of land & premises & every part thereof
