 they the said land & Neg. are to return to the quiet & peaceable possession
 of the above bounden Edmund Day heirs without let molestation or
 hindrance then this Obligation to void & of none Effect otherwise to
 remain in full force & Virtue in Law

 Violet a wench Chelsy a boy Tom a Child To have & to hold the said above
 Bargained Negroes to the said Edmund Day heirs Executors & assigns
 or assigns as his & their own proper goods & Chattles to his & their own
 proper use & behoof for ever & I the said Curt Tucker my heirs &c. Verily of
 us the said bargained Negroes unto the said Edmund Day heirs &c.
 against all People shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents
