Know all men by these presents that I Edmund Day of Southampton County & Colony of Virginia am held & firmly bound unto Curle Tucker of Elizabeth City County & Colony of afores^d in the penal sum of one hundred pounds Virginia Currency to which payment to be well & truly made to the said Curle Tucker his certain attorney his heirs &c. I bind myself my heirs & executors &c. firmly by these presents sealed with my seal & dated this thirtieth day of Sept in the year 1774

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bounden Edmund Day hath bargained and sold unto the said Curle Tucker one Tract of Land Situate in Northampton County near Roanoke whereon I Days father formerly lived together with the Stock Consisting of Cattle & Hogs together with the Crop of Corn now standing for the sum of Three hundred pounds with Int from Next Christmas to be paid at two payments (Viz) on the 25 of December 1774 & on the 25 day of Dec^r 1775 which s^d Curle Tucker is to perform again the time appointed in the above obligation is void on Days side or part & when the said Tucker doth make the above payments according to the time limited that then I Edmund Day or his heirs is to make s^d Curle Tucker or his heirs a lawful deed of conveyance then the above obligation to be void & of none Effect otherwise to remain in full force & Value in Law.
