This Indenture made the 11th day of December in the year of our Lord
1774 Between William Fowler of Southampton County, Colony of
Virginia of the one part & Jacob Williams of the county aforesaid of
the other part Witnesseth that the said William Fowler for and in consideration
of the sum of Twelve pounds to him in hand paid before the Enacting hereof
of these presents have granted bargained & sold & do by these presents
grant bargain & sell unto Jacob Williams his heirs &c. a certain
tract or parcel of Land situate in the county of Southampton aforesaid
on the south side of the Cypress swamp containing by Estimation fifty
acres be the same more or less bounded as follows (to wit) beginning
at a Maple in a small branch then by a line of marked trees to a well
oak a line tree of Jacob Williams a former possession then along a line
 Hickory a corner of Simon Barretts land then along said Barretts
line to a pine a line tree of James Barretts then along said Barretts
line to a pine then by a line of marked trees to a black Gum in the head
of the branch first mentioned then down the said branch to the beginning it
being part of a patent granted to Edward Barnes to hold the said Land & premises
thereon or thereupon with appurtenances unto the said Jacob Williams his heirs
and assigns forever & the reversion & reversions remainder & remainder with
& services of all & singular the said premises & also all the right title
Interest property claim & demand of him the said William Fowler of in
to the same & the said William Fowler doth hereby for himself his heirs
&c. covenant grant & agree to with the said Jacob Williams & that the said
Jacob Williams his heirs &c. shall & lawfully may from hence forth
forever hereafter peaceably & quietly have hold occupy possess & enjoy the
said land & premises aforesaid & sufficiently save & keep harmless of & from all
Troubles Charges & Incumbrances whatsoever by him the said Wm Fowler
his heirs Exors & assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever with
warrant & power defend & for Witness whereof the said Wm Fowler
hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & date before mentioned
