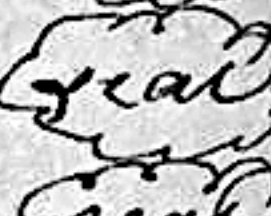
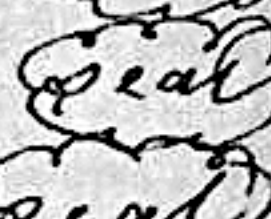
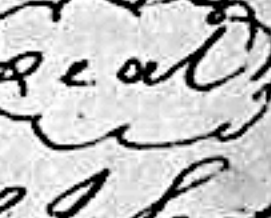

This Indenture made this 9 day of February the year of our Lord Christ 1775 Between Arthur Cobb & Susannah his wife of the county of Southampton & parish of St. Luke of the one part & John Beal of the parish of Motloway & county aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur Cobb and Susannah his wife for & in consideration of the just sum of Two hundred pounds & current money of Virginia by the said John Beal to them in hand paid at or before the enrolling & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Arthur Cobb & Susannah his wife doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said John Beal his heirs & assigns forever & themselves therewith fully & entirely satisfied & contented & as the said Arthur Cobb & Susannah his wife hath granted bargained sold alien released set over delivered & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto him the said John Beal his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation meadow tract & parcel of land whereon the said ^{Arthur Cobb} now lives situate lying & being in the parish of St. Luke & County of Southampton containing by Estimation 15 acres be the same more or less being all the lands in the possession & vision of the said Arthur Cobb of the said County & bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a maple a corner tree
