To Henry do grant in consideration of the sum of six hundred and twenty Dollars
Blunt money of Virginia by the said Thomas Blunt in hand paid to the said William
do grant bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Blunt his heirs & assigns
forever, a tract or parcel of Land situate & being in Northover parish
& Southampton County aforesaid; containing by Estimation thirty three
acres be the same more or less & is bounded as followeth, to wit, beginning
at a white oak on the road side & running thence N. 22 deg. W. 120
pole to a white oak thence N. 62 deg. E. 60 Pole to a Logwood on the road side apace
thence down the various courses of the said road to the first mentioned
station, and all houses outlying gardens, Orchards, woods, ways, water
hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any
wise appertaining & the revision & reversion remain due & remain due
unto profits & Joins thereof and all the Estate right title & property of him
the said William Scott of in & to the same with the appurtenances To have
and to hold the said tract of Land & premises with the appurtenances
