his wife or to the same or any part and all deeds evidences and writings touching or in any wise concerning the same To have and to hold the aforesaid two plantations tracts or parcels of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said Stephen Williamson his heirs and assigns ^{for} the only proper use and behoof of him the said Stephen Williamson his heirs and assigns forever and the Chaplain Williams and his wife for themselves their heirs executors admors doth hereby covenant grant and agree to and with the said Stephen Williamson his heirs and assigns by these presents that they the said Chaplain Williams and his wife their heirs executors and admors the aforesaid plantations tracts or parcels of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said Stephen Williamson his heirs and assigns against them the said Chaplain Williams and his wife their heirs and assigns and against all other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents and also that they the said Chaplain Williams and his wife shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter upon request and at the costs and charges of the said Stephen Williamson
