whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and dis-
charge the said Joseph and William Scott their executors and

Joseph and William Scott and their heirs and assigns for ever
all that plantation tract or parcel of land whereon the said
John Johnson of Ken now lives containing by estimation six

fellow called Robin and four work horses and Two Bids
together with all houses outhouses edifices buildings woods
ways waters watercourses profits commodities hereditaments
