This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of April in the year
of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy four
Between John Bradley and Mary his wife of the county of South
ampton one the one part and James Moore of the aforesaid County
of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Bradley for and
in consideration of the sum of five pounds seventeen shillings current
money of Virginia to him in hand paid at the inscaling and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Hath granted
bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said James
Moore his heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of
land lying and being in the county aforesaid and bounded as
hereafter mentioned to wit beginning at a dead pine and running
thence North sixty nine degrees east forty poles to a pine thence
south twenty one degrees east fifty six pole to a white oak thence
south seven degrees west twenty seven pole to a pine thence north
fifty eight degrees west twenty eight poles to a pine thence
eighteen degrees east forty two poles thence north forty six
degrees west twenty eight poles to a pine from thence north 86
degrees west fifty eight poles to the beginning containing
eleven acres three rods and seventeen poles be the same more or
less with all profits and advantages whatsoever to the same be-
longing in any wise appertaining to the said land and pre-
misses with all and singular the right title claim and demand
of him the said John Bradley of in and to the same belonging
so have and to hold all and singular the lands and premises
with their appurtenances unto the said James Moore his heirs
and assigns and to the only proper use and behoof of the said
James Moore his heirs and assigns forever and the said John
Bradley and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs &c. The
said land and premises unto the said James Moore and his heirs
or assigns with warranty and for ever defend against the claims
and demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever

have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year as
above writtten
