 Sealed with my seal and dated thirteenth day of February
 Anno Domini 1775

The Condition of the above obligation is such that
 Whereas the above named John Beale hath bought a certain
 tract of land of the above bound Arthur Cobb as comprized in deed
 from said Cobb to said Beale bearing date the ninth day of this
 month 1775 Now if the above bound Arthur Cobb his heirs or
 assigns shall will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
 John Beale his heirs or assigns all damages costs expences and advantages
 that to the said John Beale or to his heirs or assigns shall arise
 accrue or happen in about or concerning any claim or demand of
 whatever kind or nature it be being made to the said lands and
 premises or any part or parcel thereof by any person or persons
 whatsoever of any kind nature or denomination whatsoever
 then the above obligation to be void or else to stand and remain
 in full force and virtue
