pounds sixteen shillings and eight pence farthing to me in hand
already paid by Lemuel Reddick of the County of nansemond a
bargain sell set over and deliver and do by these presents bar-
gain sell set over and deliver in plain and open market to the
said Lemuel Reddick three feather beds and furniture one wooden
wheel one table nine pewter dishes eighteen pewter plates seven
pewter Basons one Iron pot one Iron Kettle and one Loom
I have and to hold the said Bargained premises with
the appurtenances to the said Lemuel Reddick, his heirs &c.
and I the said Richard Johnson for my self my heirs &c.
do covenant promise and agree that I have a good right
and lawfull authority to sell the same and with warrant
and for ever defend against the lawfull claims of all and
every person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof
I the said Richard Johnson have hereunto set my hand
and seal this twelfth day of December 1774

This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of
September in the year of our Lord christ one thousand seven
hundred and seventy and four Between Ephraim Beal of the
county of Southampton and parish of nantoway of the one part
and James Jordan Scott of the parish and county aforesaid
of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Ephraim Beal for and
in consideration of the full and just sum of fifteen pounds current
money of Virginia by the said James Jordan Scott to him in hand
paid at or before the inscaling and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof the said Ephraim Beal doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and for ever discharge the said James Jordan
Scott his heirs Executors administrators and assigns and himself
therewith fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid Hath
granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over and
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
release and confirm unto the said James Jordan Scott his heirs
and assigns for ever all that plantation messuage tract and
parcel of land wherein John Beal deceased father of said Eph-
raim Beal did formerly live situate lying and being in the
parish of nantoway and county of Southampton aforesaid con-
taining by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or
less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a poplar
tree the north west side of the Indian field branch a corner of Francis
Bracy's line thence a line of marked trees crossing the said branch
to a pine
