This Indenture made the nineteenth day
of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five Between Jesse Harris and Mary Harris
his wife of Southampton county of the one part and Benjamin
Clifton of the said county and parish of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Jesse Harris and Mary his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
and thirty pounds current money of Virginia to him in
hand paid by the said Benjamin Clifton the Receipt whereof
the said Jesse Harris and Mary his wife doth hereby
acknowledge have bargained and sold aliened and con-
firmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien
and confirm unto the said Benjamin Clifton his heirs and
assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of land containing
one hundred and thirty seven acres be the same more or less lying
and being in Southampton County on the North side of the flat
swamp and bounded as followeth Beginning at Joshua
Harris's Mill thence south down the various courses of the
said run to the flat swamp thence west up the various course
of the said swamp to John Greens line a gum thence north a
long a line of marked trees to Joshua Harris line thence to the mill
pond thence down the swamp of the mill pond to the first station
To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of land with
the appertinances unto the said Benjamin Clifton his heirs and
assigns together with all profits Commodities advantages
Inheritments whatsoever and also the reversion and reversions
Remainder and Remainder Rents and services of the said land &
premises and every part thereof and also all the estate right
title interest claim and demand whatsoever of the said
Jesse Harris and Mary his wife their heirs Executors and
of in and to the said land and premises above mentioned
and every part thereof with the appertinances unto the said
Benjamin Clifton his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Jesse Harris and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs the said
land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against
me my heirs and against all and every other persons or persons
whatsoever the said Benjamin Clifton his heirs and assigns
shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents in
