and Sarah his wife of the county of Southampton of the one part
and Joshua Hines of the county aforesaid of the other part Witness
that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty six pounds by
the said Joshua Hines to the said to the said William Scaggin and
Sarah his wife in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof the said William Scaggin and
Sarah his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit
and discharge the said Joshua Hines his heirs and assigns forever
by these presents they the said William Scaggin and Sarah his
wife hath granted Bargained sold aliened released and
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
release and confirm unto the said Joshua Hines his heirs heirs
and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate
lying and being in the county of Southampton on the South side
of the Asomassock swamp containing by estimation Eighty two
acres be the same more or less which said tract or parcel of land
was purchased of William Bosman by the aforesaid William
Scaggin and conveyed to him by a deed of Bargain and Sale
bearing date the ninth day of January in one thousand seven
hundred and seventy two reference being had thereto may
appear and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a
Red oak by the side of the old road thence along the said road
