of the sum of Forty one pounds Ten shillings current money of Virginia
bathem in hand paid by the said Bridgman Joyner at or before the
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said
Jesse Council and Lydia his wife doth hereby acknowledge they the
said Jesse and Lydia hath granted bargained and sold aliened
enfeoffed and confirm'd and by these presents doth grant bar-
gain and sell alien and enfeoff and confirm unto the said Bridg-
man Joyner his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or
parcel of land containing one hundred acres more or less situate
lying and being in Southampton County being part of a patent the
said Council purchased of David Burn, of the aforesaid County
and Province in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven
hundred and sixty beginning at a gum saplin standing ~~there~~
in the meadow branch at the main road that leads to Col
Browns ferry so down the various courses of the run of the said
