This Indenture made this twenty seventh day
February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
seventy six Between Phillip Booth late of the county of South-
ampton of the one part and Moses Booth of the said county
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Phillip Booth
for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds current
money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Moses
Booth the receipt whereof the said Phillip Booth doth
herby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold
aliened and confirmed and by these presents Doth grant
bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Moses
Booth one certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being
part the County aforesaid and part in the county of Sussex and
on the west side of the paper branch containing by estimation one
hundred and seventy three acres more or less and bounded by
Henry Blows line in the county of Sussex on the north by the
paper branch on the east side and by a line of marked trees on
the side of the lightwood swamp on the south side of the said
land till it joins Henry Blows line aforesaid also all woods
underwoods ways waters watercourses also the reversion and
reversions remainder and remainders Rents and services of
the said premises and of every part thereof and Also all the
estate right title Interest claim and demand whatsoever of him
the said Phillip Booth of in and to the same premises and every
part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said
premises within mention'd and every part and parcel thereof with
the appurtenances unto the said Moses Booth his heirs and assigns
for ever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Moses Booth
his heirs and assigns for ever And the said Phillip Booth for
himself and his heirs the said lands and premises and every
part thereof against him and his heirs and against all and
every other person and persons whatsoever shall and will
Warrent and for ever defend unto the said Moses Booth his
heirs and assigns In Witness whereof the said Phillip
Booth hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day and year
