Lemore before the sealing or delivering of the presents the receipts whereof he doth hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained sold alien infeoff Released and confirmed and by these do Bargain sell alien and infeoff release and confirm unto the said John M. Lemore his heirs and assigns for ever all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Southampton county which said tract or parcel of land was by John Maclemore conveyed by deed to Henry Mounger containing by estimation Eighty acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) bounded by John Calthorpes line on the outside and Fanks branch on the other side Thomas Cliftons line and a line of marked trees from
