 sand seven hundred and seventy six Between Joel Davis and
 his wife Ann of the one part and John Morris of the same
 county of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Joel Davis and
 wife Ann for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds
 twelve shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid
 at or before the inscaling and delivery of these presents the re-
 ceipt of which and themselves fully satisfy'd contented and
 paid doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained
 and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth
 give grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the
 said John Morris his heirs and assigns for ever a certain
 tract or parcel of land being part of the lands he purchased
 of John Taylor containing by estimation seventy Eight acres
 more or less and bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine
 in a small branch thence south forty two degrees east thirty
 six poles to two small red oaks thence North thirty degrees east
