six Between William Selks and Ann Selks his mother of the county  
of Southampton of the one part and John Menglemoria of Sussex

and Ann Selks for and in consideration of the sum of one hund-  
red and thirty pounds current money of Virginia to them in  
hand paid by the said John Menglemoria the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged they the said William and Ann Selks  
have granted bargained and sold aliened released conveyed  
and confirm'd unto the said John Menglemoria his heirs  
and assigns for ever one certain plantation tract or parcel of  
land containing by estimation two hundred and thirty five  
acres be the same more or less and is bounded as follows  
to wit Beginning at a pine stump in Shawell Shanis mill  
pond near the run thence along the said Shanis line to a  
gum a corner tree between Shawell Shanis and John Fork thence  
along the said Fork line to Richard Johnsons on the flat bank
