named Charles Webb and Lucy his wife she being first privately
examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made the second day of August 1776
Between David Selk of the county of Southampton of the one part
and Jacob Barnes of the said county of the other part Witnesseth
that whereas the said Jacob Barnes did at the request of the
said David Selk become security for his the said David Selk's
administration upon Joseph Selk his fathers estate and whereas
the said David Selk thinks it but just that the said Jacob
Barnes should be indemnified and made secure for any and all
damages that he may sustain by such his becoming the said
David Selk's security by conveying to the said Jacob Barnes and abso-
lute title an authority in 175 acres Land five slaves viz^t Rose
Celia, Amelia, Ben^d & Sam^l, 18 Shakes 4 saws & pigs, 1 Bed & furniture
3 Axes 3 plow hoes a parcel of pewter and all my crop of corn now
in the field for him the said Jacob Barnes to make sale of to the
best advantage and to apply the money arising ^{from} such sale
first to the payment of any and all sums of money that he the said
Jacob Barnes may be oblig'd to pay in consequence of his
becoming such security and the Balance if any to be apply'd
as the said David Selk shall hereafter direct Now this
Indenture Witnesseth that the said David Selk in pre-
sence of the premises and for divers other considerations him-
self unto moved but more especially for and in consideration of
the sum of five shillings to him in hand paid on or before the
sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof
he the said David Selk doth hereby acknowledge that
granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release
and confirm unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs & assigns
all that the said David Selk his plantation tract or parcel
of land and appurtenances situate lying and being in the
county aforesaid being the plantation whereon the said
David Selk now lives containing 175 acres be the same
more or less and five slaves with all the other aforement-
ioned estate for the purposes aforesaid and for no other
intent or purpose what soever the aforesaid Land & slave
