To all christian people to whom these presents shall
come I Joseph Vasson senior of the county of Southampton in Vir-
ginia send greeting in our lord god everlasting know ye that
I the said Joseph Vasson senior for the love and affection the
said William Vasson of the county and colony aforesaid I the
said Joseph Vasson senior being in perfect sence and memory
have given granted and confirm'd and by these my present
writing do fully freely and absolutely give grant and confirm
unto the said William Vasson and his heirs for ever all that
piece tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hun-
dred and sixty acres of land be the same more or less situate
and being on both sides of Susquehannah swamp in the afore-
said county of Southampton and bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning at the mouth of Potbelly meadow Branch thence
across Susquehannah swamp thence down Susquehannah
as far of the main run of the said swamp as the waters shall
flow and down to a white oak a corner tree of my son Joseph's
line thence across Susquehannah swamp thence up the said
swamp as far of off the said swamp as the waters shall flow to
up the mouth of a small Branch thence up the ^{main} run of the said Branch
to the head thence a line of marked ^{tree} to a pine in William Sandeford line
and up the said line to a white oak a corner tree of Arthur Arrington's
line thence Arrington's line to the head of Potbelly meadow Branch
thence down the main run of the said Branch to the beginning
And as a farther confirmation of my love and affection I the said
Joseph Vasson sen^r do by these presents do give freely and abso-
lutely grant the same land and with the appurtenances as afore-
said unto the said William Vasson his heirs and assigns forever
without any challenge claime or demand of me the said Joseph
Vasson sen^r my heirs or any other person or persons whatsoever
and I the said Joseph Vasson sen^r all and singular the aforesaid
land and premises with and every of their appurtenances unto
the aforesaid William Vasson his heirs and assigns for ever ages
all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend
by these presents and the said Joseph Vasson sen^r have put the
William Vasson in full and peaceable possession by delivering the
said land and premises to him the said William Vasson by the due
form of livery and seizen which said livery & seizen was made to
the said William Vasson the same day of the date hereof in witness
I the said Joseph Vasson sen^r have hereunto set my hand and
seal this twelveth day of Sept^r in the year of our lord christ one
thousand sevenhundred and seventy six
