So all christian people to whom these presents shall come I Joseph Vasson sen.^r of the county of Southampton in Virginia send Greeting in our Lord God everlasting Know ye that I the said Joseph Vasson sen.^r do bear unto my beloved son Joseph Vasson jun.^r of the county and colony aforesaid I the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r being in perfect sence and memory have given granted and confirmed unto the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r and his heirs for ever all that piece back or parcel of land containing by estimation two hundred and sixty acres be the same more or less situate and being on the north side of Susquehanna swamp in the aforesaid county of Southampton bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at the mouth of a small Branch betwixt me and Thomas Lanes land thence up the said branch to a pine thence Lanes line of marked trees to a white oak on the side of a small branch Between me and Jesse Jones thence up the main run of the said branch to a pine thence along Jesse Jones line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree of Jesse Jones line thence a line of marked trees to Richard Ponds line thence Ponds line to a white oak, thence a line of marked trees down to the fork Branch then across the said Branch by a line of marked trees to a white oak In Susquehanna swamp thence down the main run of the said swamp to the Beginning And as a further confirmation of my love and affection I the said Joseph Vasson sen.^r do by these presents do freely and absolutely grant the same land and with the appurtenances aforesaid unto him the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r his heirs and assigns for ever without any Challenging claim or demand of me the said Joseph Vasson sen.^r my heirs and assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever and I the said Joseph Vasson sen.^r all and singular the aforesaid land and premises with their appurtenances unto the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r his heirs and assigns forever against all persons whatsoever shall warrant and for ever defend by these presents and the said Joseph Vasson sen.^r have put the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r in full and peaceable possession by delivering the said land and premises to him the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r by due form of livery and seizen which livery and seizen was made to the said Joseph Vasson jun.^r the said day of the date here In Witness I the said Joseph Vasson sen.^r have here unto set my hand and seal this the twelfth day of Dec^r in year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and sixty six
