To all people to whom this present writing shall come we Samuel Kindred and Ann Kindred his wife send greeting
Know Ye that we Samuel Kindred and Ann his wife of Southampton County and parish of St Lukes as well for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my beloved son John Kindred of the county and parish aforesaid as for divers other good causes and considerations me herunto moving having given granted and by these presents do fully clearly and absolutely give grant and confirm unto the said John Kindred all and singular our right title claim or demand whatsoever in that tract or parcel of land belonging to the estate of Benjamin Crocker deceased and now occupied by Sarah Crocker containing in the whole Four hundred eighty six acres (one fifth of which being our right) To have and to hold the said right title claim or demand whatsoever as aforesaid to the aforesaid John Kindred his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns to his or their own proper use and behoofs for ever therefore and therewith to do use and dispose at his and their own will and pleasure as of his and their own proper right without any manner of challenge claim or demand of us the said Samuel Kindred and Ann his wife or of any other person or persons for us in our names by our cause or consent or persons meant and further Know Ye that we the said Sam. Kindred and Ann his wife have put the said John Kindred in full possession of all and singular the aforesaid premises by the delivery unto him In Witness whereof we have herunto set our hands and seals this fourth day of October Anno Domini
