Executors administrators or either of them or their assigns for which

I have Recd the sum of One hundred and Sixty pounds
Pounds Virginia Money and I do hereby warrant and for
ever defend the said Negroes from myself my heirs Executors
Administrators or either of them to Hardy Pope his heirs Executors
Administrators or either of them in the sum of Five hundred pounds
Virginia Money Whereunto I have hereunto set my hand &
seal this first day of February Anno Domini 1777
