

Crenshaw This Indenture made this thirty first day of January and in
 the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven
 Whittington between Thomas Crenshaw of the parish of St Luke and County of South-
 ampton of the one part and Howell Whittington of the same County and
 parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas
 Crenshaw for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty
 pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said
 Howell Whittington the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 granted bargained sold Released and confirmed and by these pre-
 sents doth fully and absolutely grant bargain sell release and
 confirm unto him the said Howell Whittington his heirs or assigns one
 certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County and pa-
 rish aforesaid containing three hundred and fifty acres more or less
 and bounded as followeth To wit Beginning at a pine tree on the South
 side of the beaver dam swamp Just below the mouth of a small branch
 then Running near a south west course up the said Branch one
 hundred and twenty pole to a pine then near an East course on a
 line of marked tree to a Red oak a made Corner standing in John
 Beals line then on the said Beals line South five degrees east to a
 pine the aforesaid Beals Corner then near an East course to the
 head of a small Branch then down the various Courses of the run of
 the said Branch to a pine then on a line of Marked trees to a pine
 in a Meadow a Corner tree of the aforesaid Beals then North
 Twenty five degrees west Fifty four poles to a white oak then East
 North East one hundred and thirty six pole to a pine a Corner tree of
 Doctor Samuel Browne land then North West by North on the Brown
 line to a Red Oak then North West Eleven pole to a Maple on the mouth
 of a Myrry Branch on the South side of the Beaver Dam swamp afo-
 said then up the various Courses of the run of the said swamp to the
 Beginning one hundred and ninety five acres of the aforesaid land
 being part of a Patent granted to John Brazwell bearing date
 September the twenty eight one thousand seven hundred and thirty two
 and one hundred Acres being a whole Patent granted to Joseph Wombwell
 dated July 9th one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven and fifty
 five acres being part of a Patent granted to Joseph Cobb by patent dated
 November the third one thousand seven hundred and fifty Together
 with all houses and buildings thereon with the reversion and re-
 versions Remainder and Remainders Rents issues and profits thereof
 and every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances To have
 and to hold the above granted tract or parcel of land with the ap-
 purtenances unto the said Howell Whittington his heirs and assigns
 to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Howell Whittington
 his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever and the
 said Thomas Crenshaw for himself his heirs Executors Administrators
 doth Covenant grant and agree with the said Howell Whittington
 his heirs and Assigns that he the said Thomas Crenshaw will
 warrant and for ever defend the above granted premises with the
 appurtenances unto the said Howell Whittington his heirs Executors
 Administrators and Assigns against the claims and demands of
 him
