pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said
Nathan and Burwell Barnes the receipt whereof the said William
Fowler doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained Sold alien
enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Nathan and Burwell
Barnes their heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel
of land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid Containing
by estimation Eight acres be the same more or less and bounded as
followeth to wit Beginning at a pine a line tree of John Whitehead
and along the said Whitehead's line to a white oak then a line
of marked trees to the Cypress road to a pine then down the road
to Jacob Barnes line along the said line to the beginning with
all trees woods underwoods commons of Commons of pastures profits
commodities and advantages implements and hereditaments whatsoever
to the tract of land belonging or in any ways appertaining or
upon the same growing happening or arising and also the reversion
reversions remainder and remainders unto services of the premises
and every part thereof and also all the estate title interest claim
and demand whatsoever of him the said William Fowler of in
or to the same premises and every part thereof To have and
to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned
and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto
the said Nathan and Burwell Barnes his heirs and assigns for
