seven hundred and seventy and seven Between James Moore and Eliza-

aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Moore
and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Forty one
pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid before the
sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof they the
said James Moore and Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and discharge the said Lewis Joyner jun^r his heirs
executors administrators and assigns forever By these presents and them
selves therewith fully contented and satisfied and paid they the said
James Moore and Elizabeth his wife hath granted bargained sold
aliened released conveyed set over delivered and confirmed and by
these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey set over and
confirm unto the said Lewis Joyner jun^r his heirs executors administrators and
assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the
County of Southampton and parish of Botolphay aforesaid containing by
estimation Eighty two acres be the same more or less It being part of
Two hundred and seventy acres of land granted to Bridgman Joyner
by patent bearing date the 11th November 1713 which said Eighty two
acres of land is lying and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a gum
in the mouth of Goodsons Branch thence up the various courses and water
courses
