This Indenture made the 12th day of June in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven Between Thomas Lane of the parish of Stottoway in the County of Southampton of the one part and Nath^l Felts of the same parish and County of the other part Whereas the said Thomas Lane hath lately become bound in a certain writing obligatory to one Richard Wren a security for the aforesaid Nath^l Felts for the sum of Eighty pounds and interest and being willing to save harmless and keep indemnified the said Thomas Lane his heirs executors and administrators from by reason of such security in case of the non payment of the said sum of money by the said Nath^l Felts according to the condition of the writing obligatory jointly entered into by them This Indenture therefore witnesseth that the said Nath^l Felts as well for and in consideration of the security ship herein before mentioned and for saving harmless and keeping indemnified the said Thomas Lane his heirs executors and administrators also for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings of his own hand paid at or before the enscating and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge Nath^l Felts hath bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas Lane his heirs executors and administrators All that plantation tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the South side of River
