said James Ingram of the County of Southampton County of the State of North Carolina
of the one part and William Peterson of the County of Brunswick
the State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
Ingraham and Mary the wife of the said James Ingram for and in
consideration of the just sum of four hundred pounds Virginia
money to him the said James Ingram in hand paid the receipt whereof
he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained and sold and delivered
unto William Peterson his heirs or assigns for ever and by this present
the said Ingram and Mary his wife doth bargain sell and
deliver unto the said Peterson his heirs and assigns forever and by
these presents the said Ingram and Mary his wife doth bargain
sell and deliver unto the said Peterson his heirs and assigns all
that part or parcel of land with all the appurtenances and the
ridges thereto belonging that the said Ingram bought of the
James Taylor being and being on the morning here in South
Carolina County near Taylors containing by estimation three hundred
and forty six acres more or less To have and to hold
the said hereditaments and tenements with all the appurtenances
thereto belonging unto the said William Peterson and his heirs
and assigns for ever and the said James Ingram and Mary
his wife doth for themselves their heirs and assigns Covenant and
agree to and with the said William Peterson his heirs &c that they
had good right and full power to sell the said land and tenements
and doth Warrant and for ever defend the same against all persons
and each person claiming any right under them at all times
past and to come the day and year first above written
