

A court held for the County of Southampton the 11th of December 1777

This Indenture and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Joshua Beal and James Wright & by the solemn affirmation of Jordan Denson (one of the people called quakers) three of the witnesses that were to be recorded

To all to whom these presents shall come (Whereas one Drury Cotton of the County of Southampton by his certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the twenty eighth day of October 1774 did sell & convey unto James Jordan Scott & to his heirs & assigns one certain tract or tract of Land whereon the said Drury Cotton then dwelt lying in the County aforesaid containing one hundred & fifty acres for the consideration & securing the amount of thirty four pounds four teen Shillings & four pence with interest then justly due to the said James Jordan Scott from the said Drury with a proviso of Redemption on the payment of the aforesaid Sum & interest to the said James Jordan Scott his Executors administrators or assigns and whereas since the death of the said James Jordan Scott the aforesaid Drury Cotton hath paid & satisfied unto Jordan Denson the lawful executor of said James Jordan Scott the aforesaid Sum of £ 34. 14. 4 & the interest arising thereon to the date hereof Now ye that the said Jordan Denson executor & of the aforesaid James Jordan Scott for the consideration aforesaid Have & by these presents Do Remise Release & for ever quit Claim unto the aforesaid Drury Cotton & to his heirs and assigns All the right title interest claim and demand of him the said Jordan Denson his executors administrators & assigns either as executor of the said Jordan Denson his executors administrators & assigns either as executor of the aforesaid James Jordan Scott or otherways of in to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land mentioned to be conveyed in & by the aforesaid indenture of mortgage herein before mentioned and hereby acquit & discharge the aforesaid Drury Cotton his executors administrators from all date & demand

This Indenture made this Day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy seven Between David Delk and Judith his Mother of the one part of Southampton County and Thomas Holiday Jun.^r of Nancemond County of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Delk and Judith his Mother doth for and in Consideration of the Sum of Two hundred and forty five Pounds Virginia Currency to them in hand paid the said Thomas Holiday at or before the sealing and Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said David Delk and Judith his Mother doth hereby Acknowledge and therefore acquit and discharge the said Thomas Holiday his Heirs Executors and Administrators forever by these presents they the said David Delk and Judith his Mother hath Granted Bargained Sold Alien Released enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents Doth grant Bargain Sell Alien Release and Confirmed unto presents Doth grant
