This Indenture made the first day of March one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven Between John Mannerwing Henry Mannerwing & William Mannerwing of Sussex County of the one part and Solomon Deloach of Southampton County of the other part witnesseth that the said John Mannerwing Henry Mannerwing & William Mannerwing for and in the consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Solomon Deloach at and Before the Ensealing and Delivering of these presents the said John Mannerwing Henry Mannerwing and William Mannerwing doth hereby acknowledge they the said John Mannerwing Henry Mannerwing and William Mannerwing hath granted Bargained and sold aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant Bargain Sole Alien Enfeoffed and Confirmed unto the said Solomon Deloach his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation one hundred and Twenty five acres lying and Being in the County of Southampton and on the South side of the Spring Swamp and bounded as followeth to Wit Beginning at Two fums by the said Swamp just above the Mouth of a branch a Corner of Adam Tapley land thence by Taples line South seventy Degrees West seventy eight poles to a pine tree thence South seventy four Degrees East seventy four poles to a White Oak then South sixty Degrees east one hundred and two poles to a pine then North fifty five Degrees east one hundred and nine poles to a Red Oak then North sixty four poles to a Red Oak then North forty Degrees west twenty said poles to a gum by the Side of the said springs swamp aforesaid and up the Various Courses of the Run of the said Swamp to the Beginning and also all Trees Woods underwoods Cammons pastures profits Commodities advantages Emoluments houses payments whatsoever to the said lands above mentioned belonging or in any appertaining or upon the same Grow happening or arising and also the Residue Remainder and Remainders Rents and Services of the said premises and Every part thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of them the said John Mannerwing Henry Mannerwing and William Mannerwing of or to the same premises and every part thereof
