 of the County of Southampton Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 Samuel Williford for and in Consideration of the sum of Forty six pounds Cur
 rent Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Woodward the receipt
 whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge that he hath granted Bargained and sold Alien
 Enfeoffed and Conferred and by these presents doth grant Bargain and sell Alien
 Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said John Woodward his heirs and assigns forever
 one certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation Seventy Acres
 more or less Situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton &
 Bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a pine Micajah Edwards line in a
 branch called the bobpen branch thence along a line of marked trees to a
 Turkey Oak in Etheldred Sainters line formerly the property of John
 Stephenson thence along the said line to a red oak a corner tree, thence along
 the said Edwards's line to a pine a corner tree of the said Willifords, thence
 along the said Edwards's line to the Beginning to have and to hold
