acknowledg and thereof doth acquit the said Richard Harrison his heirs Exe
cutors and administrators Hath granted Bargain and sold Alienated Enfeoffed Confirm
ed & made over unto the said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns forever
all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of
Southampton in Virginia near Meherrin River Beginning at persons upper corner
formerly a Hickory now a large sycamore then a straight line to the mouth of
a small branch in the old field thence the deviding line between Arthur Turners
Deceased. and said tract to a small pine Opposite the upper end of a path
of race paths then Down the said paths to Simon Harris line along his line to
a corner pine thence along the said Harris line to a Red Oak thence along the said line
to a Red Oak a corner in William Harrisons line thence along the said line to persons
line thence along the said line to the beginning containing by Estimation One hundred
Acres be the sum more or less, the said land being part of a larger Tract held
by John Ruffin Deceased, and conveyed to the said Francis Ruffin by will Relling
being thereunto had may more fully and at large appear also the Reversion and
Reversions, Remainder & Remainders to have and to hold the said land
