

This Indenture made this the 8th Day of January Between Stephen Johnson and Mary his wife of the County Southampton and parish of Nottoway of the one part and Burwell Rawlings of the other part witnesseth that that the said Stephen Johnson and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten pounds current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid before the Ensealing and Delivering of these presents the receipt thereof and themselves fully satisfy contented and paid and do by these presents grant bargain and sell alien release and confirm unto the said Burwell Rawlings one tract or parcel of land lying and being in said County of Southampton and parish of Nottoway containing by Estimation one hundred & forty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning on Browns Branch on William Simmons's line thence by Simmons's line to the meadow then up meadow to the old Indian line then by the said line to Richard Blows line and by the said Blows line to the above Brown Branch then down the said branch to the beginning as well also appear by a deed of Thomas Chappell sent to Thomas Chappel gun: being date one thousand seven hundred and seventy one and recorded in the County Court of Southampton the Eleventh day of April one thousand seven hundred and seventy one. also all Woods under woods ways water and water courses and also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders Rents and Services of the said premises and Every part thereof and also all the estate right title Interest Claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Stephen Johnson and Mary his wife of in and to the same premises and all and every part thereof with the said appurtenances belonging or in any wise appurtened thereto. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with their appurtenances to the said Burwell Rawlings his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Burwell Rawlings his heirs and assigns forever and the said Stephen Johnson and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs Executors administrators or assigns the above mentioned premises With the said appurtenances and every part thereof against themselves and against their heirs Executors administrators and assigns and against all and Every other person or persons whatsoever Claim or laying any Claim or title thereunto to the said Burwell Rawlings his heirs and assigns shall and will Warrent and forever by these presents defend in Writs Whereof the said Stephen Johnson and Mary his wife have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and Year first above Written
