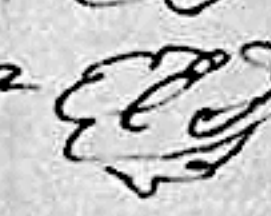

This Indenture made this twelfth day of March in the Year of
our Lord Christ one thousand Seven Hundred and seventy Eight
between Joshua Harris and Olive his wife of the County of South-
ampton of the one part and Henry Thomas of the said County of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Joshua Harris and Olive
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
and ninety five pounds Current money of them in hand well and
truly paid by the said Henry Thomas, the Receipt whereof they
the said Joshua Harris and Olive his wife doth hereby acknowledge
they the said Joshua Harris and Olive his wife do grant bargain
and sell alien enfeof and confirm by these presents unto the said
Henry Thomas a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and
in the said County of Southampton and on the north side of the
flat swamp containing by estimation One hundred acres be-
the same more or less and is bounded as follows to wit Beginning
at Herberts Swamp joining Sawit Claws line from thence near
or quite a south Course along a line of mark trees that divides the said
Land from Sawit Claws land to a white Oak a corner red Tree
