<sup>Nicolson</sup> This Indenture made this thirtieth day of March in the year <sup>10</sup> of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight between Sarah Nicolson of the county of Southampton of the one part and her son Joseph Nicolson of the said county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Sarah Nicolson for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Joshua Nicolson, the Receipt whereof the said Sarah Nicolson doth hereby acknowledge she the said Sarah Nicolson hath and doth grant bargain and sell aliened off and confirm unto the said Joshua Nicolson one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the said county of Southampton and on the south side of the Three Creeks containing four hundred and twenty five Acres be the same more or and is bounded as follows to wit on the north side by the Three Creeks on the west by George's Branch that divides
