Dewry to Kirby
This Indenture made this 27th Day of January in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy eight Between Samuel Dewry and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part Witnesses that the said Samuel Dewry and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of forty Pounds Current Money to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Kirby the Receipt whereof the said Samuel Dewry doth hereby acknowledge he the said Samuel Dewry and Elizabeth his wife have bargained and sold Alien and confirmed and by these presents doth grant Bargain and sell Alien Confirm unto the said Benjamin Kirby one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being on the east side of the Apsomsock Swamp in the County of Southampton aforesaid and containing by Estimation sixty two Acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at an ash a Corner tree on the said Kirby's line on the East Side of Apsomsock Swamp and running North thirty Degrees West forty six poles to a black Gum in the Mouth of the swack house branch thence up the various courses of the said Branch to a dead oak a corner tree near the head of the said Branch on the said Kirby's line thence down the said Kirby's line to the ash at the Beginning To have and to hold the said Land above mentioned and every part thereof unto the said Benjamin Kirby his heirs and Assign forever the only proper use and behoef of him the said Benjamin Kirby his heirs and Assigns forever And the said Samuel Dewry for himself his heirs the said Land and every part thereof against him and his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever the right and title of the said Land to the said Benjamin Kirby his heirs and Assigns shall and will Warrant and forever Defend by these presents I witnesses whereof the said Samuel Dewry and Elizabeth his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their Seals the Day and year above written
