This Indenture made this 11th day of June in the Year of our
 Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy eight Between
 Stephen Williamson of the County of Southampton of the one part
 and John Wilkinson of the same County of the other part Witness
 that the said Stephen Williamson for and in consideration of the
 Sum Six hundred and Eighty pounds current money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid by the said John Wilkinson as or before the
 sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof
 the said Stephen Williamson doth hereby acknowledge hath
 granted bargained sold Alien and confirmed and by
 these presents doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien and confirm
 unto the said John Wilkinson and to his heirs and assigns forever
 a certain Tract or parcel of Land and being in the County of South
 ampton & containing by estimation Two hundred & fifty Acres be
 the same more or less bounded as followeth. Beginning at a Red
 Oak by the side of the Road in the County line, thence along
 said line to white Oak Pileans Corner Tree, thence along said
 pitmans line to the meadow Branch thence up the various
 courses of the said Branch to a gum Cooks corner, thence on
 his line to a Gum Benjamin Tuckers corner in the Nash Bra
 thence down the said Branch to a poplar Tuckers corner, thence
 along said Williamson & Wilkinson's lines to a pine & Gum In
 the Turter Branch thence up said Branch to a pine in
 said Branch, thence along a line of marked Trees to a white
 Oak by the side of Road aforesaid thence down the said line
 to the Beginning the said Land being part of large Tract sold
 said Williamson by Cheplen Williamson and all houses out
 houses edifices Buildings yards Gardens Woods Trees ways
 water and water courses profits commodities hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said Tract or parcel of Land
