This Indenture made this tenth day of January one thousand  
seven hundred and seventy eight Between Jesse Lumley and his wife  
of the County of Southampton of the one part and John Kindred of the  
County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jesse Lumley  
and his wife  
by for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds Virginia Currency  
to them in hand paid by the said John Kindred, the Receipt whereof  
the said Jesse Lumley and Lucy his wife doth hereby acknowledge  
have granted bargain'd and by these presents do grant bargain and  
sell unto the said Kindred his heirs and assigns one certain  
Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of South-  
ampton containing Sixty five Acres more or less and is bounded  
as followeth To wit. Beginning at a white oak on the South side  
of Kingtons Branch thence South fourteen Degrees west Sixty pole  
to a white oak by a small branch side then down the run of the  
Branch to the beginning Together with all houses Orchards woods  
ways waters and water Courses profits Commodities hereditaments &  
appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land and premises belonging  
or in any wise appertaining & the Reversion and Reversions  
and remainders and every part and parcel thereof To have  
and to hold the said granted Land and premises to him the said  
John Kindred his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns  
forever and the said Jesse Lumley & Lucy his wife for them &  
their heirs doth covenant and agree to & with the said Kindred
