This Indenture made this Tenth Day of September in Year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight in the third Year of the Commonwealth between John Admiston Rogers of York County of the one part and Thomas Day and Mary his wife of the County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Day and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the Sum of Three hundred and fifty pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Admiston Rogers the receipt whereon the said Thomas Day and Mary his wife doth hereunto acknowledge have granted bargained and Sold Alien and Confirm and by these presents do grant bargain sell Alien & Confirm unto the said John Admiston Rogers his Heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land contained by Estimation Two hundred and forty Three Acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine corner of Richard Taylors land by the side of Cocks Swamp thence by the said Taylors line to a white Oak corner of Clauds Land thence along the said Clauds line to a live Oak corner of Blake land in the pond Branch thence along pole line to a corner of John Barrows land in the pond
