This Indenture made this Second Day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Seventy Seven Between Joel Bird Winne his wife Priscilla Gurley and Lucy Pitman of Southampton County of the one part and Lazarus Cook of the aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joel Bird Winne his Priscilla Gurley and Lucy Pitman for and in Consideration of the Sum of Eighty pounds Current Money of Virginia to us in hand paid by the said Lazarus Cook before the Insealing and Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Joel Bird Winne his wife Priscilla Gurley and Lucy Pitman doth hereby Acknowledge themselves fully satisfied and paid and hereof doth acquit and Discharge the said Lazarus Cook hath Granted Bargained and Sold and by these presents doth Grant Bargain and Sell unto the said Lazarus Cook his heirs Executors Administrators one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid on the south side Tarrorack Creek and on the North side of Moheering River containing by estimation one Hundred a Forty Acres. be the same more or Less and Bounded as follows Beginning at a pine in the pine pole Branch then by a line of Marked Trees to a live oak a corner Tree then by a line of marked Trees to a pine in a meadow Branch thence up the meadow Branch to a gum thence to the marsh Branch then down the said marsh Branch to a Sweet Gum a corner Tree then by a line of marked Trees to pine pole Branch thence Down the said pine pole Branch to pine at the first Beginning it being part of a patten granted to Thomas Pitman Junr for four hundred Acres bearing Date the Twentieth day of March One Thousand Seven hundred and Twenty five and since by Divers Conveyances became vested in us the reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders to have and to Hold
