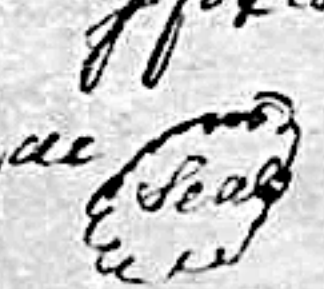


Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the just & full sum of thirty pounds current Money of Virginia to the said Christopher Wade by the said James Wilson in hand paid before the Ensigning & Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & thereof Acquitt & Discharge the said James Wilson his Heirs and assigns forever & the said Christopher Wade doth acknowledge himself fully Satisfied & paid and the said Christopher Wade have Granted bargained Sold Alien & confirmed and by these presents Doth Grant bargain Sell Alien Release Deliver & confirm unto the said James Wilson & to his Heirs and assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land Containing one hundred acres more or less lying in the parish & county aforesaid Beginning at a pine a corner Tree in William Joyner's line. Thence a line of Marked Trees on Joyner's line to a white oak near the fork of a Branch in Joshua Turners line. Thence a line of Marked Trees on the said Turners line to a black Oak a corner in the said Turners line thence a line of Marked Trees on the said Turners line to Henry Joyner's line thence a line of Marked Trees on Joyner's line to a pine a corner Tree thence a line of Marked Trees to a pine the Beginning place To have and to hold the said one hundred Acres of Land more or less to the said James Wilson his Heirs and assigns forever and the said Christopher Wade for myself my Heirs & Executors & administrators. Shall and Will Warrants and forever defend the said Land and premises unto the said James Wilson his Heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever from all manners of persons laying any Claim by From or under them In Witness whereof the said Christopher Wade hath hereunto set his hand and affixed my Seal the day and ~~Yede~~ above Written Christopher Wade ^{his} mark
