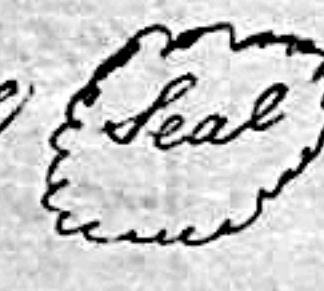


Content therewith and hath Bargained and Sold Alien enfeoff and
